

Honor Guard at Funerals

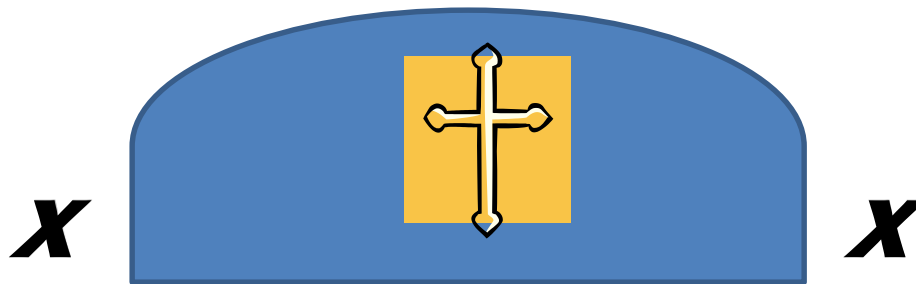
All participants should wear white in honor and respect for their deceased sister.

White under robes with white shoes

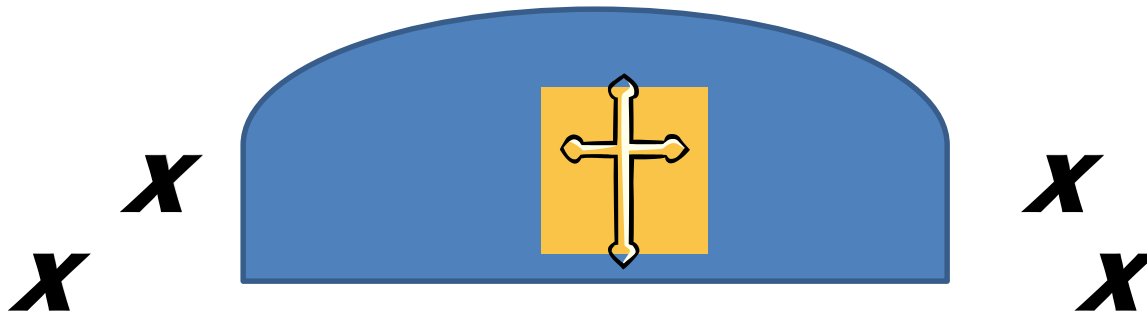
All Honor Guard participants are to sit together

Assign an usher to change the guards approximately every 15 minutes

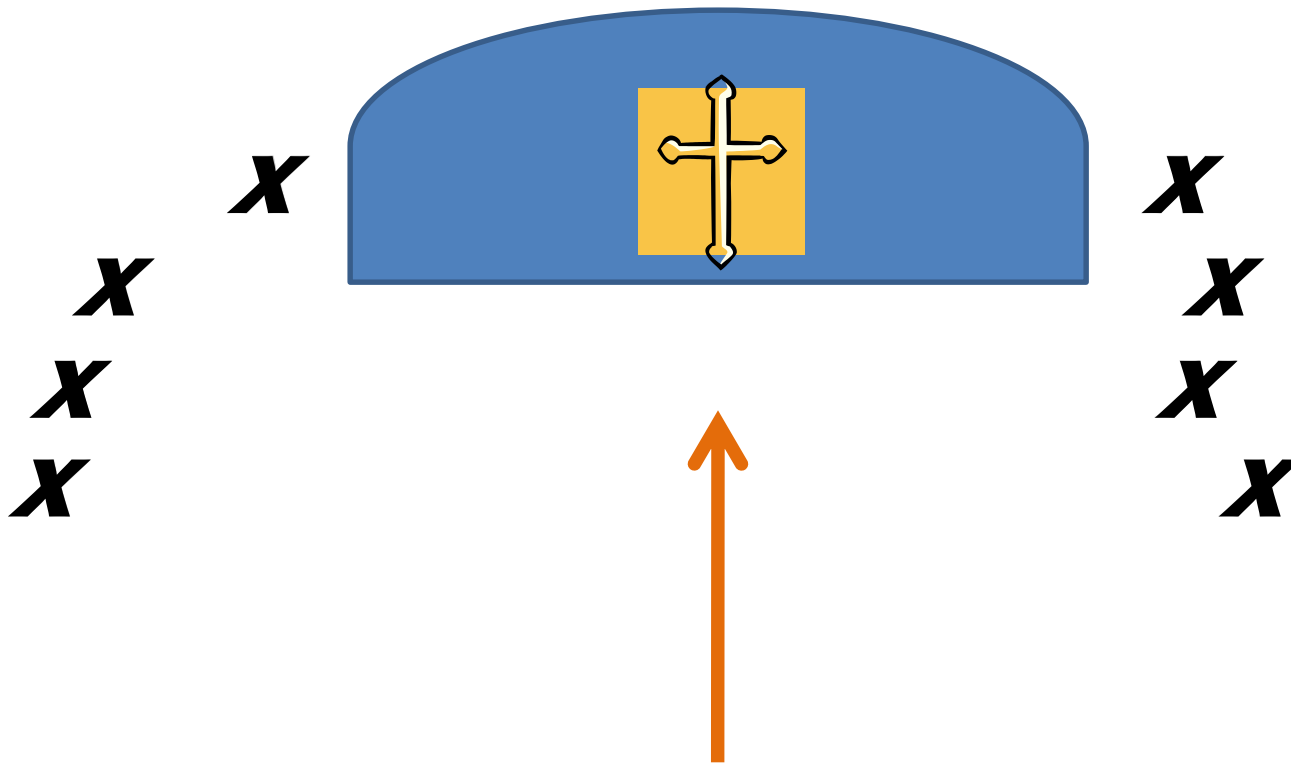
One Honor Guard on each end of the casket
facing one another



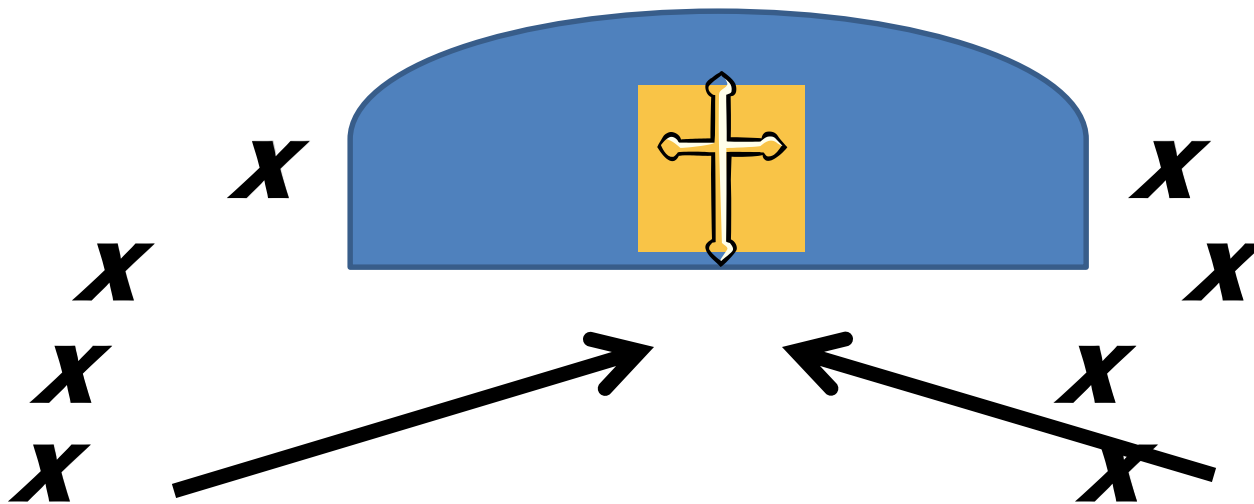
Two Honor Guards on each end of the casket
facing one another



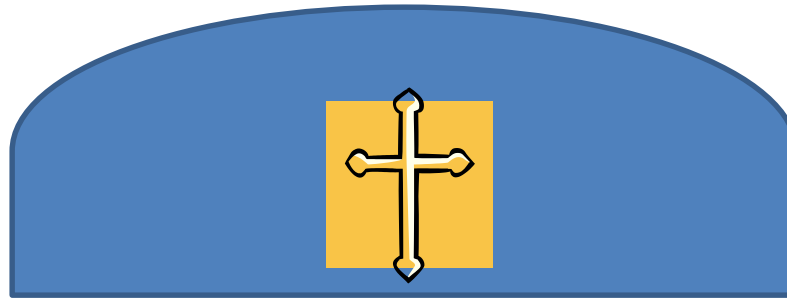
Guests still have plenty of room to go up to the casket



Honor Guards on the outside end of the line move towards the center of the casket for a final good bye.



Member on the end leads back to the pews.



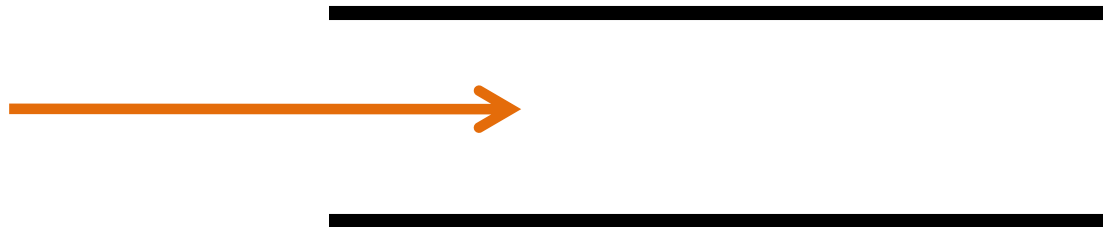

Prior to the end of Mass

Quietly leave the pew and form two single lines in the foyer of the church.

Members facing one another for the casket and family to pass through.
